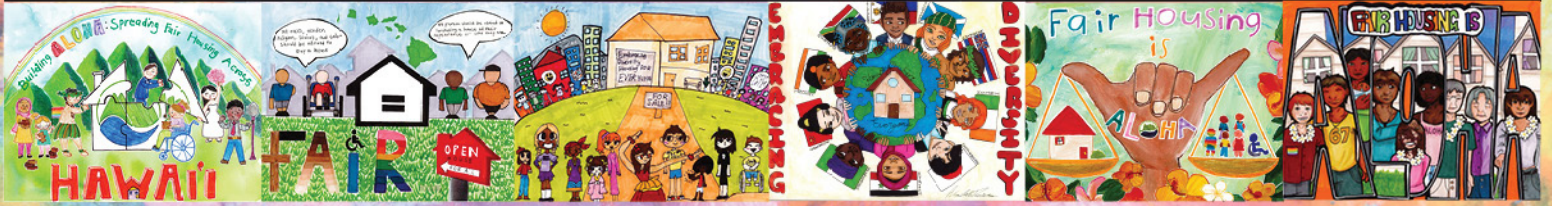

FAIR HOUSING

Each year, Hawai'i REALTORS®, the statewide association of REALTORS®, commemorates the Fair Housing Act, a law that prohibits discrimination in housing based on race, color, religion, ancestry/national origin, sex, familial status, physical or mental disability, marital status, age, or sexual orientation and gender identity. This law ensures that everyone has equal access to housing and protects homebuyers from discrimination as they get a mortgage, rent a home, buy a home, seek housing assistance, or participate in other housing-related activities. Our Keiki Art Contest helps children learn about fair housing rights and its importance in Hawai'i's communities.

2026 ART CONTEST THEME: "Open Homes, Bright Futures"

A home can be the beginning of a dream, a new opportunity, and a brighter future. Fair housing helps ensure that people have a fair chance to find a home where they can live, grow, learn, and thrive. Through their artwork, keiki are invited to show us what "Open Homes, Bright Futures" means to them and imagine a future where fair housing creates opportunities for people and families throughout Hawai'i.

CATEGORIES

Grades K-4 | Grades 5-8

Open to any student in grades K-8, enrolled in a public, private, charter, or home school in Hawai'i

FORMAT

- Submitted artwork must be original and on paper, not to exceed 8.5" x 11" in size. **No AI-generated or AI-assisted artwork or computer art. Entries must be 100% hand-created by the artist.**
- Acceptable media: paint, pencil, markers, ink, crayon, and watercolor
- One entry per student (name must be on back of artwork)

PRIZES (for each age category)

1st Place: \$250 (plus artwork featured on a printed 2027 calendar)

2nd Place: \$150

3rd Place: \$75

Winners will be announced by the end of November 2026.
