The REALTORS® Political Action Committee of Hawai‘i (“RPAC”) meeting was held on Friday, June 26, 2020, via Zoom. The meeting was called to order at 9:04 a.m.

## MINUTES

The Committee welcomed special guests Kristian Hoysradt, NAR Political Representative for Region 13 and Judy Zeigler NAR RPAC Trustee for Region 13.

## CONGRESSIONAL RACE (OPEN SEAT)

Judy Zeigler Region 13 Disbursement Trustee provided an update and noted that on May 16, 2020, NAR RPAC approved HAR RPAC’s recommendation of \$2,000 for Congressman Case which is the maximum for the primary election.

The RPAC Trustees discussed recommending to the National Association of REALTORS® for Congressman Ed Case, in which he has been a REALTOR® Champion.

Kristian Hoysradt, Region 13 NAR Political Representative provided an update on the process for the Congressional HI-02 Open Seat race vacated by Congresswoman Gabbard.

**By direction of the RPAC of Hawaii, it recommends to the National Association of REALTORS® to support Hawaii State Senator Kai Kahele for the maximum of \$5,000 for the primary election. Motion carried.**

HAR Government Affairs Director Ken Hiraki provided an update on the Hawai'i legislative races.

**By direction of the RPAC of Hawai'i, it approves the Hawai'i State Senate RPAC disbursement recommendations as circulated. Motion carried.**

**By direction of the RPAC of Hawai'i, it approves the Hawaii House of Representative RPAC disbursement recommendations as circulated. Motion carried.**

**By direction of the RPAC of Hawai'i, it approves the Open Seat races and an additional Senate race recommendation for RPAC disbursement as circulated. Motion carried.**

*C. Kapono Pa disclosed a conflict and recused himself from the vote.*

An update was provided on the status of trademarking the new Hawai'i RPAC logo, renaming Hawaii's PAC to Hawai'i RPAC and approved by the HAR Board of Directors to fund one RPAC representative to attend REALTOR® Legislative Day.

**The RPAC Trustees discussed fundraising and noted many planned fundraising activities have been put on hold due to the COVID-19 pandemic.**

The next RPAC meeting is on August 20, 2020, via Zoom.
